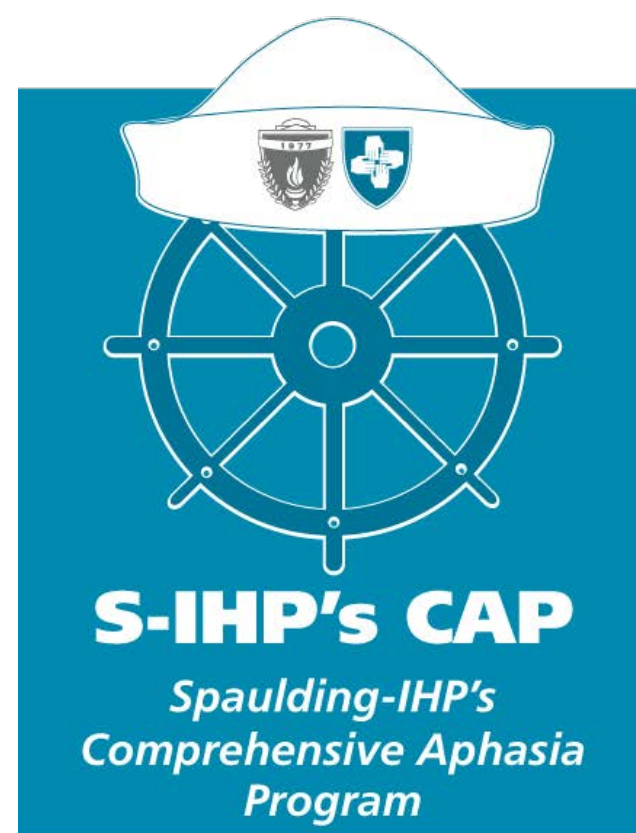

What is **Aphasia**?

A language disorder caused by damage to the brain from a stroke or traumatic brain injury

What is **S-IHP's CAP**?

5-week intensive comprehensive program for people with aphasia.

This interprofessional program follows the Life Participation Approach to Aphasia (LPAA).

Participants target their goals through personalized interventions focused on daily activities that mean the most to them.

Though individual outcomes vary, past participants showed improvements in standardized language scores and increased confidence in communication situations.

Who is **Eligible to Participate**?

Adults ages 18 or older who:

- Have been living with aphasia for at least 6 months
- Are English speaking
- Are not receiving other therapies
- Are comfortable with group activities
- Can complete 8 hours of activities with breaks
- Can manage personal care and medications independently or with help from their caregiver
- Can provide their own transportation to and from the program



Activities occur at:

MGH Institute IMPACT Practice Center & Spaulding Rehabilitation Hospital



Proof of COVID-19 vaccination (2 shots plus booster) is required to participate in the program. Masks will be provided and should be worn at all times during program activities.
